ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT

As an athlete of the Oak Harbor Wrestling Club:

- 1. I will work in practice to improve my skills.
- 2. I will tell coach of any injuries or problems I have with my skin.
- 3. I will learn the rules of wrestling and the policies/expectations of the OHWC.
- 4. I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, wrestler, parent or spectator such booing and taunting; verbal and physical threats; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
- 5. I will not use any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and or well-being of any athletes.
- 6. I will wrestle by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 7. I will treat other wrestlers, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- 8. I will remember that doing one's best is more important than winning, regardless of the outcome of a match, tournament finish, or my performance.
- 9. I will praise my teammates for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my teammates feel like a winner every time.
- 10. I will never ridicule or yell at my teammates or other participants for making mistakes or losing a competition.
 - 11. I will remember that skill development and practices improve my ability.
- 12. I will respect the coaches and officials and their authority during wrestling matches and practices and will never questions, discuss or confront coaches or officials.
- 13. I will remember that being part of the OHWC is a privilege and it is my responsibility to keep that privilege.
- 14. I will respect everyone's right to a healthy, productive practice environment and will not distract myself or teammates during practice.
- 15. I will wear the designated OHWC team singlet or compression gear to all competitions.
- 16. I will remain in designated areas during tournaments, meets, and practices, and not approach mat side unless I am coaching or getting ready to wrestle.
